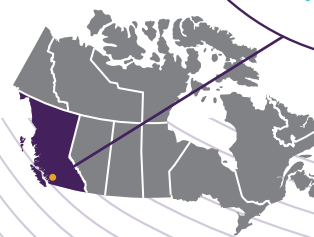
The Best of City and Nature

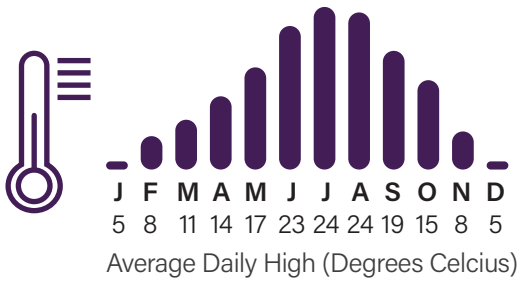

INTERNATIONAL Student Program

The Surrey Schools International Program welcomes students from 25+ countries worldwide. We provide an exceptional academic program, supportive environment and enriching social opportunities for students to succeed.

PROGRAM INFORMATION

- **Enrollment:**
Students can start their program in either September or February, for a minimum of one semester (5 months).
- **Online Application:**
No Application fee and space permitting, you can choose your school.
- **Secondary Schools:**
All secondary schools are grade 8-12.
- **Semester System:**
All secondary schools run on the semester system, except for grade 8-10 at Johnston Heights, and grade 8-9 at Panorama Ridge and Salish (linear -8 full year courses).
- **Semesters:**
September to January - students complete 4 courses
February to June - students complete 4 courses
- **Holidays:**
The school year has two holiday breaks.
Two weeks in the winter (late December - early January)
Two weeks in the spring (mid-late March)
There are no classes on statutory holidays (Easter, Thanksgiving, etc.) and on teacher professional development days.
- **School Hours:**
Classes run approximately 8:30 am - 3:00 pm with a 40 minute lunch break.
- **Lunch:**
Students can bring their lunch from home, or purchase food in the school cafeteria.
- **Assessment:**
Students are assessed upon arrival and then depending on their goals and abilities, are scheduled into appropriate levels of ELL and academic elective courses.

STUDENT SUPPORT SERVICES

- **English Language Learning (ESL or ELL):**
English language learning support is available at all schools.
- **Orientation:**
One week before the semester starts, students attend a district-wide orientation day. This helps introduce international students to Surrey Schools and prepare them for academic and social success.
- **International Student Coordinators:**
Dedicated teachers assist with academic advising and ELL support. They monitor attendance and academic achievement, and organize exciting activities and events for international students at each school.
- **Multi-Cultural Workers:**
Assist students in their first language, attend school meetings, help with student assessments and provide translation for families.
- **Summer School:**
One of the largest academic summer school programs in BC. International students can take full credit courses at an additional fee to support or fast track their learning.
- **Post-Secondary Fair:**
The International Student Program offers an annual post-secondary fair for international students with over 30 different universities and colleges across Canada represented.
- **Parent Program:**
A free twice-a-week English language program for parents of international students. This helps parents develop their English language skills, learn about life in Canada and better understand how to support their child's learning.

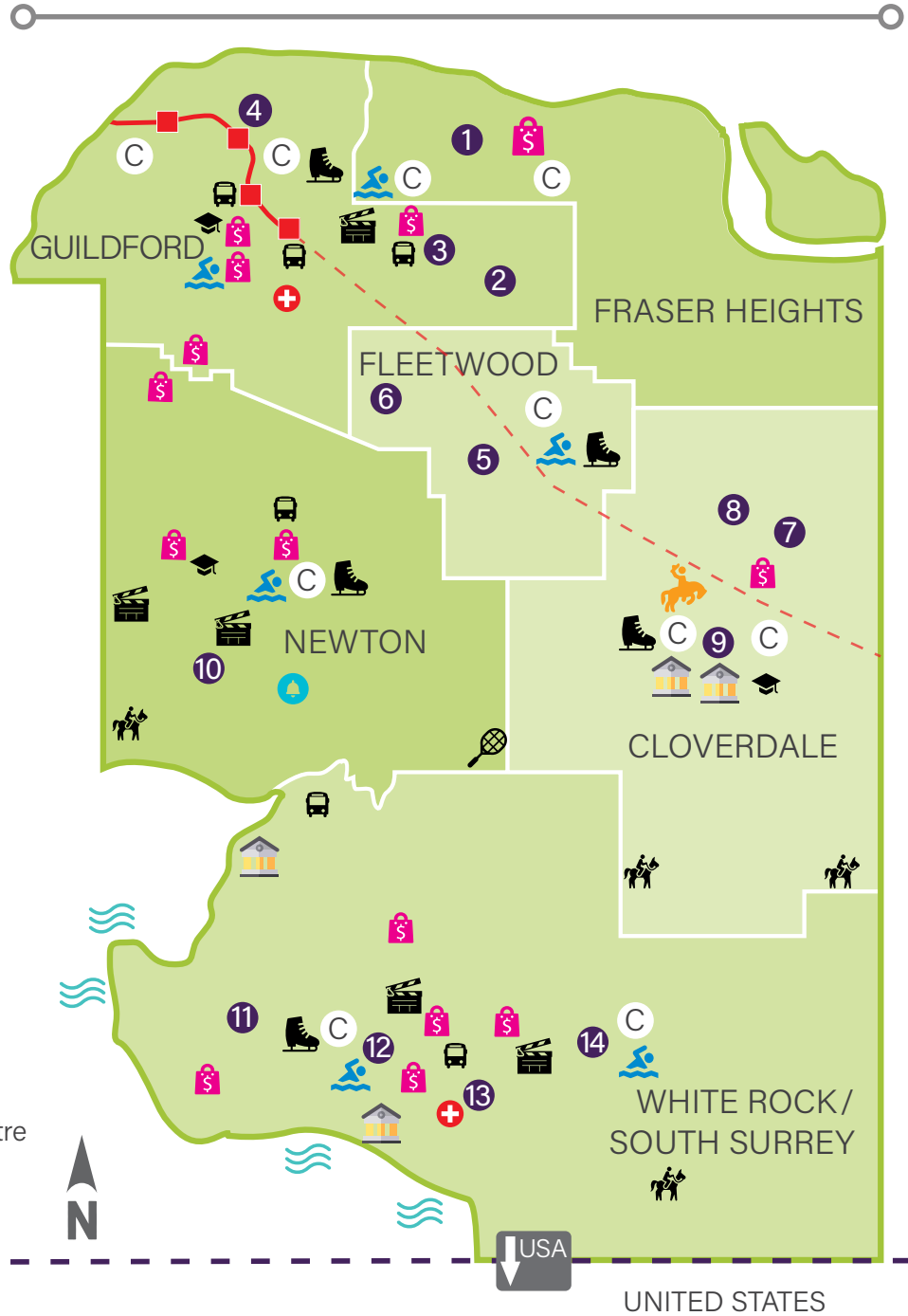

Located in the north east of Surrey in a quiet residential area, Fraser Heights is very close to shopping, restaurants and excellent transportation options in the Guildford area. Fraser Heights Secondary is located next to a brand new community centre, with tennis courts and sports fields. This area is popular with families and has many large homes and parks.



Recreation Centre

Academics:

A highly academic school that has a history of outstanding performance in all aspects of high school curricula. FH offers senior students a two-year Science Academy which allows students to earn first-year Chemistry or Computer Science credits at Simon Fraser University. FH also has Advanced Placement (AP) courses in Calculus, Physics, Psychology and Economics.

Electives:

FH offers several Business courses, Computer Technology, Trades and Technical education, Robotics, pre-Engineering, Media Studies, Art, Music and Athletics.

Highlights:

FH traditionally has over 50 student clubs and is one of only two schools to offer Japanese and an after-school Mandarin program. Graduates from FH successfully gain admission to top post-secondary institutions in Canada and the United States.

Highlights:

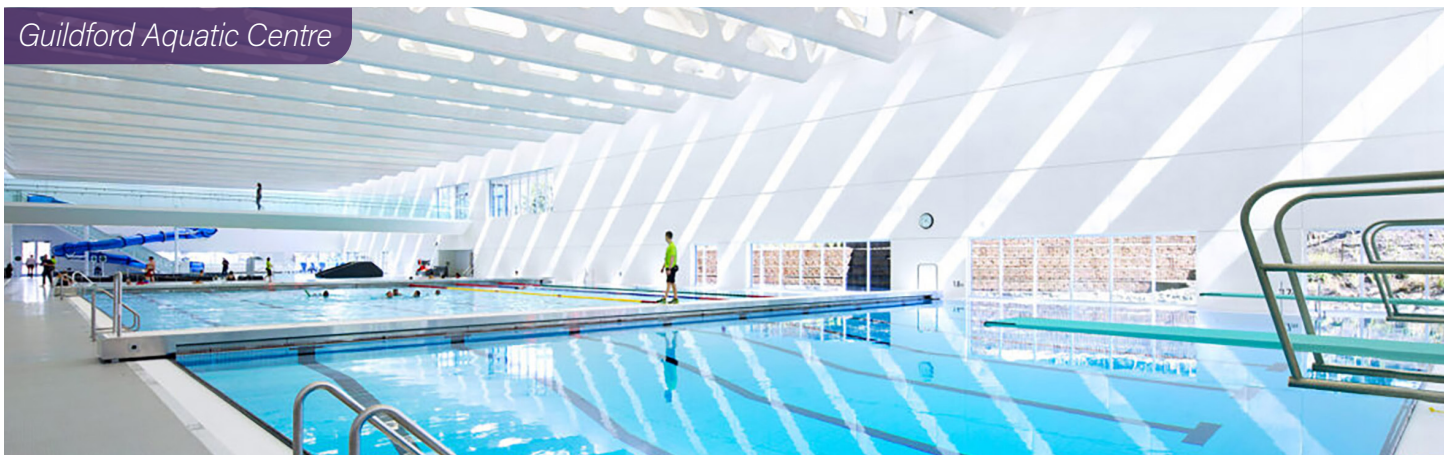
A bright and modern school, JH boasts a first class Music program featuring Concert Band, Jazz Band and a world-renowned choir. JH also has an outstanding student leadership program.

Centrally located in the heart of Surrey, Fleetwood is one of the city's primarily residential neighbourhoods. The Surrey Sports and Leisure Complex in Fleetwood offers three full-sized skating rinks, Olympic swimming pools and fitness areas. This area has over 25 parks, including the Surrey Lake Park, but is still very close for students to access shops and restaurants in the Guildford area.

FP is one of Surrey's most popular school choices for students. This school has a very strong academic program with a variety of senior courses in Science, Mathematics, English and Social Studies. FP offers Advanced Placement (AP) courses in Calculus and Chemistry.

Electives:

FP is also very proud of its Visual and Performing Arts Departments. Additionally, the school has an excellent Culinary Arts Training program and is one of the only schools to offer elective choices such as Engineering and Design, several types of Dance and Choreography classes and Student Leadership.

Highlights:

In addition to a highly successful Athletics program, FP offers a wide variety of extracurricular clubs and opportunities for students. FP is an inclusive, caring and welcoming community of students and staff.

Academics:

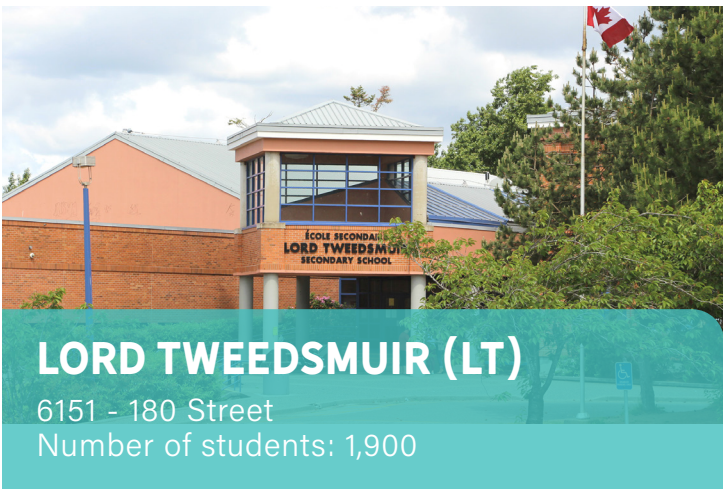
In the heart of downtown Cloverdale, LT is home to strong academics, dynamic technology and a Fine and Performing Arts program that includes Film and TV Production courses.

Homestay Guidelines:

- Homes are inspected and must ensure a safe, clean comfortable environment.
- Caring and supportive families speak English and treat students like one of the family.
- Students are provided with a private bedroom, study facilities and three healthy meals each day.
- Typically, homes are within a reasonable walking distance to schools (5-20 minutes).

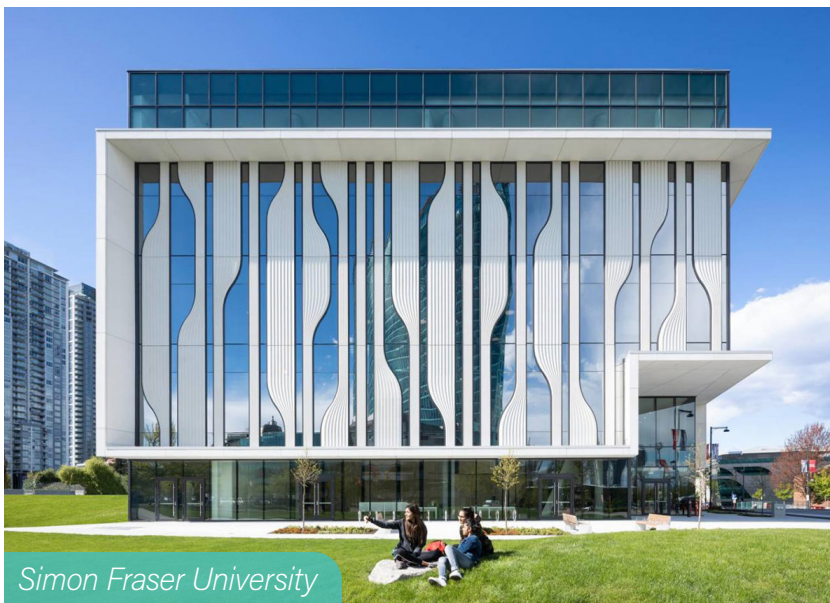

City Transit

The highlight of Metropolitan Vancouver's rapid transit network, SkyTrain offers riders fast, frequent, high-capacity service. The goal of the SkyTrain and transit is to get Surrey residents where they need to go quickly, safely, and affordably.

With an anticipated opening date of 2028, the Surrey-Langley SkyTrain expansion will connect three different SkyTrain lines – Millennium, Expo, and Canada, resulting in over 100 kilometres of track.
